### DR CONGO

Covenant Kids Congo supports the work of the Congo Covenant Church (CEUM) in partnership with Covenant World Mission, Paul Carlson Partnership, and Women Ministries of the Evangelical Covenant Church. The needs are great, and in response, each of these ministries is building into peoples' lives, bringing hope for today and equipping them for the future. The CEUM is involved in educational programs for children, youth, young adults, and women. These programs give older participants practical skills and job training, along with "tools of the trade," and give younger participants a foundation for lifelong learning.

### SOUTH SUDAN

Covenant Kids South Sudan supports the work of the Evangelical Covenant Church of South Sudan (ECCSS). Founded in 1998, the ECCSS has taken root in the face of civil unrest, war, displacement, poverty, disease, and death. Today, Covenant World Relief and Covenant World Mission partner with the ECCSS to respond to these overwhelming needs through education, medical care, community development projects, and by training the next generation of church leaders. One such school, the Good Hope Academy in Bentiu, offers Sudanese children an education and a daily, nutritious meal. Nearly half the students at the academy are girls, compared to the national average of only 18 percent.

### INDIA

Covenant Kids India supports the work of three partners:

The Child Development Centre, founded by India for Christ Ministries (IFCM), is an informal education program that provides holistic care and development for underprivileged, orphaned, and deserted children in and around Bangalore. The center cares for more than 600 children.

Truthseekers (TS) operates neighborhood schools dedicated to the education of underprivileged children in India, and in 2006 opened several schools in the Delhi metropolitan area. Classes meet from August to April, providing basic schooling and a meal a day for 600-800 often forgotten children.

The Hindustani Covenant Church (HCC) has established programs to meet the needs of people in central India who do not have access to clean drinking water, electricity, medical care, or daily meals. Covenant Kids India supports several Hindustani Covenant Church schools and programs that minister specifically to children, including child laborers, ragpicker children, and the children of sex industry workers.

### COLOMBIA

Covenant Kids Colombia partners with the Colombia Covenant Church (CCC) to improve the quality of life for needy children. By supporting local church ministries around the country, Covenant Kids Colombia is effective in helping children in the areas of education, health, recreation, and spiritual formation. Currently there are many ministries that directly address the needs of neighborhood children in Barranquilla, Medellin, Bogota, and Monteria. Hundreds of children already benefit from educational support, meals, and encouragement but there are hundreds more who need your help.
