The church has been called by Christ to serve as his body, to care for those who are marginalized and oppressed, to bring hope and healing to broken lives and broken relationships, and to speak boldly against the injustice of violence against women, men and children.

In 2004 the Covenant Church made a courageous commitment to partner with God in ending domestic and sexual abuse, knowing they exist not only in our communities, but also in our congregations. AVA has expressed our faith community's commitment to stand up for the downtrodden and broken.

AVA (Advocacy for Victims of Abuse)

- **Provides** resources for victims of abuse and those who minister to them.
- Equips the church to minister to victims by:
 - Providing AVA workshops/seminars on domestic violence and adult survivors of sexual abuse.
 - -Recruiting and trains Regional Coordinators and Local Advocates.
 - Providing online training for Covenant leaders.
- Promotes preventative measures against abuse.

WHY AVA?

- Every 15 seconds a woman is battered
- 3 or more women each day are murdered by their husbands or boyfriends
- 2 to 4 million women are abused each year
- 3.3 to 10 million children are exposed to domestic violence every year
- 30% to 60% of children exposed to domestic violence are also physically and/or sexually abused
- Over 40% of male and female high school students have been victims of dating violence at least once.
- I in 4 women will experience abuse (rape or physical assault) in their lifetime
- I in 6 men will experience physical abuse in their lifetime
- I in 4 girls is sexually abused before the age of 18
- I in 6 boys is sexually abused before the age of 18
- I in 5 children are solicited sexually on the internet
- An estimated 39 million survivors of childhood sexual abuse exist in America today and 30-40% are abused by a family member
