

Singing Bird Origami

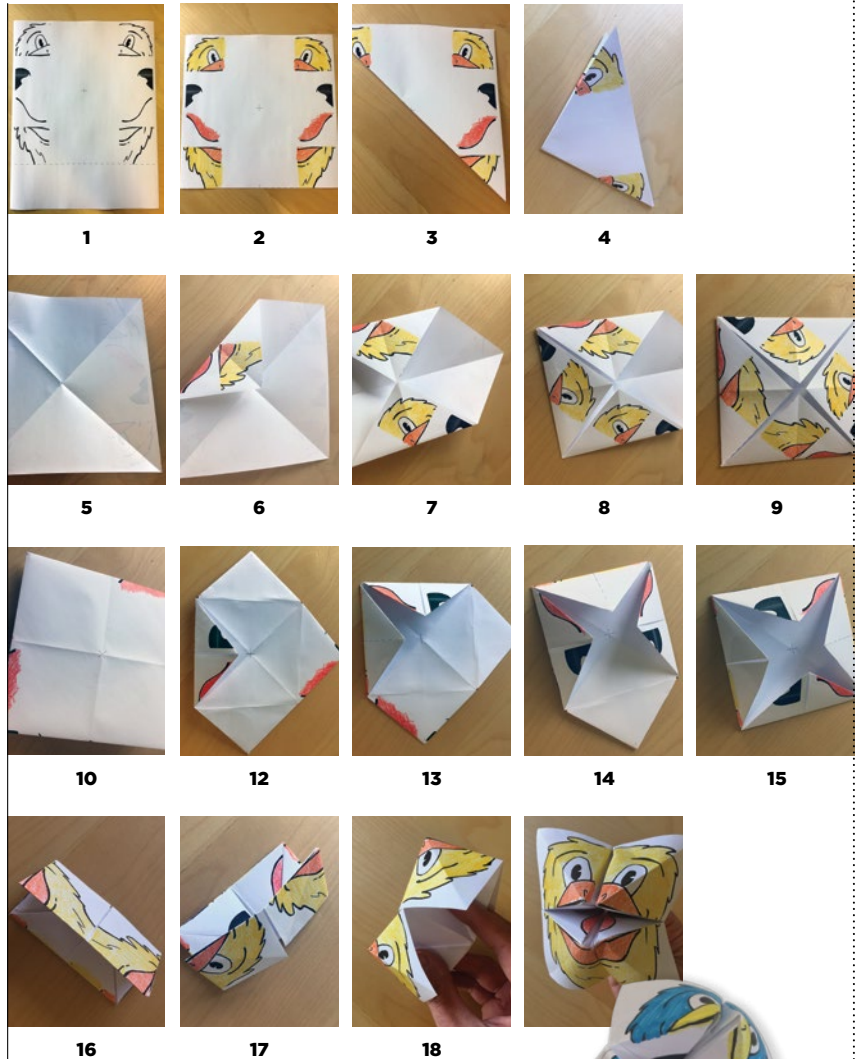
INSTRUCTIONS:

Cut sheet along the dotted line to make the paper square. Allow students to color their own bird. It is a good idea to have one already colored so they can see what the different parts should look like. For instance, the tongue looks nothing like a tongue until it is folded. Fold in half on the diagonal. Fold in half again on the diagonal.

Unfold and flip paper so that the colored side is facing down. Fold one corner so that the tip meets exactly in the center. Repeat for the other three corners.

Flip the paper so that the colored side is facing down. Fold one corner in so the tip meets in the center (just like you did before). Repeat for the other three corners.

Fold in half along the horizontal axis. Unfold and fold in half along the vertical axis. Insert thumb and finger under flaps. If needed, color in any white spaces.



Ask the children to use their new origami birds to sing a song of praise to God.
