Sonu Nimba Pawa, age 9, lives with her parents and a younger brother in the village of Chopda in India. Her father has been ill with tuberculosis for a year, and is addicted to alcohol. His addiction and illness has resulted in financial hardships for the family.

Through the Balwadi (non-formal school) program run by the Hindustani Covenant Church in Chopda, Sonu now has access to education. Along with other children, Sonu also receives a small scholarship to assist with costs for school supplies, school uniforms, food and personal items.

In this picture, Sonu is wearing her new school dress and proudly holding her new backpack. With the amount that was saved, she asked her mother to use it to buy fruit for her family and medications for her ailing father.

South Sudan



Tharijat Kuich, age 16, currently lives in Kule 2 Refugee Camp. He comes from Maiwut County, Upper Nile State in South Sudan. He has been a part of the CovKids program since 2011. Tarijath lost his father during the ongoing South Sudan civil war in December 2013. He lives with his mother who was disabled during the war and is unable to walk.

Through the support received from CovKids, Tharjiath has the opportunity to go to school at Kule 2 Refugee Camp CovKids Primary School in Ethipoia. His teachers describe him as a smart and talented student. Tharijat loves studying Scripture and hopes to become a Pastor.

The CovKids program in South Sudan helps pay for learning material, school fees, and supplies. In addition, the program provides a nutritious breakfast to students before school starts and footwear for them to wear to walk to school.
