The family has been a member of ECCSSE for the past eight years.
Through the funding of school fees and

supplies provided by CovKids, Chudier is now in sixth grade at the Evangelical Covenant Primary School. She dreams of becoming a civil engineer in order to build roads and bridges when she finishes her studies.



DR Congo

Debokose endured a long period of illness before she was healthy enough to have a child. Finally, the joyful day came when she gave birth to her daughter,

Ngolu. However, Ngolu struggled with her health from the beginning. Despite Debokose's best efforts, Ngolu was not gaining weight and was mostly inactive. She was not taking steps toward learning to walk.

Debokose's restored health began to decline from anxiety.

about her life. All this questioning directly affected my health and I was

losing weight," says Debokose.

Thankfully, Debokose was able to take her daughter to the local health center resourced by Covenant Kids Congo/World Vision.
Ngolu was quickly diagnosed with malnutrition and immediately began to receive

treatment which included a vitamin-rich diet comprised of locally-sourced foods.



Debokose learned new food preparation techniques to provide her daughter with the nourishment she needed.

Ngolu developed a healthy appetite and by the time she was 18 months old, her weight had increased to nearly 20 pounds. She finally gained the strength she needed to learn to walk. With deep relief and gratitude, Debokose says, "Now Ngolu is well and I am very happy to see her playing with her friends. I dream that my child can become a nutritionist when she grows up."



India

Caught in poverty, Mohini was only eight years old when she left school to help her mother earn an income for the family. When Mohini turned 11, she pleaded with her mother to send her younger siblinas to



school. Her mother had no choice but to say no. Her income was only enough to feed the family two meals a day.

One day, Covenant Social Services (CSS) staff member Mrs. Suchita visited the family and asked Mohini and her sister to join the Child Development Centre. Mohini could not attend regularly because of her responsibilities and the family's expenses. Mrs. Suchita consistently visited her and provided extra tuition while preparing Mohini's sister for schooling as well.

CSS has invested time, energy, and financial assistance to prepare both girls for schooling over the last six months. Mohini and her sister are now attending formal school. CSS is thankful for the

sponsors of CovKids for transforming the lives of children like Mohini.
