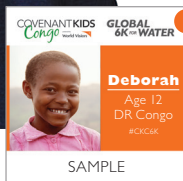

FOR YOUR CHURCH

The **Global 6k for Water** is a meaningful way to disciple your congregation and engage your community, while expanding access to life-giving clean water in DR Congo.

DISCIPLESHIP: This is a spiritual as well as a physical challenge. Watch your church community grow in their spiritual journeys as you walk together in prayer for our sisters and brothers in DR Congo.

OUTREACH: Invite family, friends, neighbors, and community members to join your church on this journey for clean water in Congo.

COMMUNITY BUILDING: Organize group runs/walks and watch relationships deepen as spiritual conversations happen naturally.

FOR THE CHILDREN OF CONGO

Nearly everyone in your congregation can walk the Global 6k—getting a glimpse of what women and children in DR Congo endure to get water. Each registration of \$50 helps expand clean water access in Congo! Each participant will get a race bib that features the photo of a CKC child who lives in this community in Gemena, DR Congo.

WATER CRISIS FACTS

- 6k (3.73 miles) is the average distance people in the majority world have to walk for water. Surface water is dirty and makes families sick.
- Clean water is rare in Gemena, the remote city in DR Congo where CKC operates. Right now, the vast majority of the population of Gemena does not have access to clean water.
- **Covenant Kids Congo powered by World Vision** is partnering with the Covenant Church of Congo (CEUM) and local leaders to expand clean water access in Gemena. The goal is universal water, sanitation, and hygiene coverage for this city of 350,000.
