**What is meant by a covenant between God and his people?**

**Who is Jesus Christ?**

**What is the sacrament of the Lord's supper?**

“The teaching that I gave you is the same teaching that I received from the Lord: On the night when Jesus was handed over to be killed, he took the bread and gave thanks for it. Then he broke the bread and said, ‘This is my body; it is for you. Do this to remember me.’ In the same way, after they ate, Jesus took the cup. He said, ‘This cup shows the new agreement from God to his people. This new agreement begins with the blood of my death. When you drink this, do it to remember me.’ Every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you show others about the Lord’s death until he comes.”

**What is salvation?**

“I tell you the truth. Whoever hears what I say and believes in the One who sent me has eternal life. He will not be judged guilty. He has already left death and entered into life.”

**What was accomplished by the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ?**

**What is the Christian hope?**
