It is our sincere hope that together we will grow deeper in Christ and further in mission. *The Meaning of Membership: Deeper in Christ. Further in MIssion. Together.* is designed to be covered in four sessions, yet we recognize this format will not work for everyone.

To the right are suggestions for condensing these resources into a one-session membership class. The Leader's Guide and PowerPoint presentations are adaptable to fit your church's context. We recommend using portions of each session's Leader's Guide in order to cover the four intersecting dimensions of mission.
