The water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) programming in Karawa and Gemena is contributing to improved child well-being through education, training, and targeted activities aimed at school children, and sanitation and hygiene improvements in homes.

Community-wide education campaigns are helping students and families understand the importance of good hygiene and sanitation practices, which are improved when clean water systems are developed.
