2023 Mission and Impact Report



• Our 816 Covenant churches reported 10,883 baptisms and commitments to Christ with 1,306 faith commitments reported by our church plants.

- All church planters received monthly coaching.
- 3.500 leaders and congregants accessed
 Missional Vitality tools to strengthen
 missional leadership and congregational life.
- 34 pastors seeking to enhance their leadership and pastoral skills received 204 hours of Missional Vitality coaching.

Holistic disciple-making resources brought together Covenanters seeking to share the story of the transformative love of Christ.

- 6 Embrace webinars—315 attendees
- Lunchbox online children's ministry community—267 members

- To date, 450 Covenant leaders have completed Antiracism Discipleship
 Pathways to enhance their ability to understand, minister to, and faithfully love our neighbors across lines of racial and ethnic difference.
- 150 Covenanters participated in cultural mosaic immersive learning experiences: Sankofa, Journey to Mosaic, and Indigenous and Immigration experiences.
- Justice Journey for Kids curriculum was downloaded 1,041 times by congregations, organizations, and families discipling children.



National Memorial for Peace and Justice



There are 2,522 Covenant pastors, global personnel, chaplains, and ministry leaders.

- 1,711 are active Covenant clergy men and women.
- 1,285 are permanent credential holders.
- 426 are licensed.
- 28% of our active clergy are women, our highest percentage to date.
- \$208,906 was granted to care for pastors to be restored through sabbaticals, Sustaining Pastoral Excellence retreats, and personal counseling.
- Three major Lilly grants awarded, totaling \$2.5 million, including a new grant for \$1.5 million designed to equip and support Covenant clergy.
- Covenant World Relief and Development distributed \$517,000 through 19 disaster response grants to India, Nepal, Japan, Morocco, Libya, Lebanon, Kenya, and Haiti including \$250,000 for Ukraine refugees and \$80,000 to earthquake response in Turkey/Syria.
- \$1.1 million to 28 partners in 18 countries including South Sudan/Ethiopia, DR Congo, India, Laos, Colombia, Ecuador, Haiti, Cameroon, Nepal, Philippines, Mexico, Honduras, South Africa, and China for 39 community development projects, including clean water initiatives, community health, anti-trafficking, refugee care, food security and nutrition, agriculture, women empowerment, and peacemaking.



More than 250 volunteers offered leadership to the Covenant on approximately 20 boards, commissions, and committees, donating an average of 20 hours per year, equivalent to nearly \$150,000 in donated work hours. We are grateful for the gifts of their time and talent to the denomination to provide guidance and expertise to governing boards.

- **Paul Carlson Partnership** assisted the CEUM medical facilities and personnel to see infant deaths decrease by 50% and maternal deaths by 78%.
- Covenant Kids Congo (CKC) sponsored nearly 700 children in 2023.
- Because of the CKC work on the ground in Congo, stunted growth in children has been reduced from 46% to 13% since 2018.
- The number of households using basic sanitation facilities increased from 11% to 36% since 2017.
- Households using basic drinking water facilities increased from 16% to 59%.
- The number of community members reporting diarrheal illnesses decreased 26%.
- 83 global personnel are serving in 25 countries.
- Four new global personnel are now serving in Sweden, France, and Israel/Palestine.
- 497 people participated in 33 ministry trips to nine different countries to serve and build deeper relationships.
