2013 ACCW Strategic Planning Process



The ACCW board met in Chicago to begin a strategic planning process. The meeting was funded by our colleagues in the ministerium and facilitated by Rev. Dr. Jo Ann Deasy. The board began it's work by listing the historical ways in which God has worked through our advocacy for clergy women over the years and the common themes that could be lifted from that history. We followed this time with a session in which we reviewed current statistics of where women are serving and the roles in which they are serving. There was a rich time of discussing our scope and guiding questions including: Who are we advocating for? Who are we advocating to? Who are we advocating with? Who are our partners? Our next session included a time of

discussing what would disappear if ACCW didn't exist, our weaknesses, threats, strengths and opportunities.

We completed the launch of our strategic work by developing beginning drafts of our purpose, vision and mission statements. We use this definition of a purpose statement: a statement of the fundamental reason for your existence. It is the motivational force that drives what you do and answers the reason for being.

The purpose statement the board will be presenting is: *ACCW Advocates for Covenant Clergy Women*. The board will ask our partners to affirm all three statements. The vision and mission statements will be emailed in the next two issues of *The Advocate*. The ACCW annual business meeting begins at 12:20 pm on Thursday, January 30, 2014.
